2	Issues on Service tax case in respect of AOA KV-II	<p>The issue was deliberated by the Treasurer, BOM that the Service Tax Department through a Notice has asked the AOA, KV-II to deposit an amount of Rs 4906910 Including penalty as service tax for a period from 2013 to 2017.</p> <p>In this context, the BOM has taken an expert opinion from Shri O P Goyal, Member/ Special Invitee who has sounded the BOM with his considered opinion that let an appeal be preferred before the Service Tax Authority for considering payment 7.5% of Rs 3,68,020/- as a service tax. and penalty on account of non-payment of outstanding service tax for the period referred above since AOA, KV-II is seemingly not at fault. Further as suggested by the Advocate Shri Ashok Batra, engaged for Service Tax Settlement Matter, 7.5 % of demand amount of Rs 3,68,020/- Lakh has to be deposited to Service Tax Department.</p>



		The BOM has also decided and approved the proposal to deposit an amount of Rs 10000. required to file the appeal, besides an amount of Rs.750/- towards fees on behalf of Shri Ramesh Chandra Upadhyaya, the then President, AOA, KV-II may also be deposited to file an appeal separately as he has been summoned in this case also.
