- (ii) The intending bidders eligible to submit the bid should satisfy himself that he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below.

- (iii) Certificate of successful completion of work in respect of the experience should be issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent. The work done certificate shall clearly indicate amount of work done, date of start, date of completion, time period (stipulated and actual). The works not completed in stipulated time where levy of compensation is imposed are not considered satisfactory for work experience.
- (a) Average annual financial turnover during the last three years, ending March 31 of the previous financial year, should be at least 12.5% of the estimated cost.

A part (maximum 50 %) of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee having validity of six months or more from last date of receipt of bids. 8. The bid submitted shall become invalid, if:

(iv) If a bidder quotes NiI rates against each item in item rate tender; or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / subhead, in percentage rate tender; the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as successful bidder.

9.If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents submitted with Bid and certified copies submitted physically by the Successful bidder in the office of bid opening authority. President, AOA shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100 % of the said earnest money. Further, the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the tendering process of the work.

10. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish **Performance Guarantee** of **5** % (Five per cent) of the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule 'A'. This guarantee shall be in the form of Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee

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Bonds of any Schedule Bank in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'A', including the extended period if any, the Earnest money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be adjusted in the aforesaid performance quarantee of successful bidder. a. Intending bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and subsoil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost, all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. - b. The bidder is permitted to use old lift parts like Car guide rails & counter weight guide rails, Counter weight Frame with Filler weights, existing brackets and buffer spring only, if found in good condition after thorough check and their satisfaction and should have residual life of minimum 15 years (Certificate to this effect must be submitted along with the technical bid). All remaining parts of dismantled lifts will be the property of KV-2 AOA.
- 12. The competent authority on behalf of the Apartment Owners Association of KV-II does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
- 13. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- 14. The competent authority on behalf of Apartments Owners Association of KV-II reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 15. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 75 days from the date of opening of technical bid. If any bidder withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the Society, then the Society shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. 7. The technical bid shall be opened first, on due date and time. Subsequently the financial bid of contractors qualifying the technical bid shall be opened either at the due date and time specified or at such date and time communicated to them at later date.

The bid would be evaluated on the basis of technical parameters as well as on financial rates quoted by the bidder. Equal weightage would be

given to both the bids.

8. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.

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#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. Suitable scaffolding, temporary barricading in the hoist way and all minor building work etc. required, shall be done by the supplier only. All steel items e.g. machine beams, bearing plates, buffer supports channels etc. at all floors and ladder in pit shall be provided by the supplier.
- 2. A set of tool kit should be provided by supplier. Operation and maintenance manual and special instruction chart shall be prominently displayed in the machine room. Wiring diagrams shall be displayed inside the panels and in the machine room.
- 3. The supplying firm shall give a guarantee of 36 months from the date of completion and handing over of the lift work against any material/manufacturing defects. During the period of 12 months, free maintenance comprising of routine/preventive as well as breakdown is also to be carried out including oiling, greasing and checking of all safety devices etc. as required. Any spare parts required for maintenance shall be supplied by the firm free of cost during this period of 36 months.
- 4. The lift shall be got inspected from the lift inspector by the supplier, if required. AOA shall pay the required fee for this.
- 5. After successful completion and inspection from the lift inspector (if required), the lift shall be handed over to the AOA, KV-II for putting the lift into service. The certificate issued by the lift inspector will be handed over to the AOA, KV-II.
- 6. #### **INSPECTION AND TESTING BEFORE DISPATCH**

For item/equipment requiring initial inspection at manufacturer's works, the contractor will intimate the date of testing of equipment at the manufacturer's works before dispatch, if so desired by the BOM, AOA, KV-II. ## STORAGE AND CUSTODY OF MATERIALS

The lift machine room may be used for storage of sundry materials and erection of equipment, if available or else the contractor has to make his own arrangement. No separate storage accommodation shall be provided by the AOA, KV-II. Watch and ward of the stores and their safe custody shall be the responsibility of the contractor till final taking over of the installation by AOA, KV-II.

## CARE OF THE BUILDING

Care shall be taken by the contractor while handling and installing various equipment and components of work to avoid damage to the building. He shall be responsible for repairing of all such damages and restoring the same to original finish at his cost. He shall also remove all unwanted and waste materials arising out of installation from the site of work from time to time.

The entire work of manufacture/fabrication, assembly and installation shall conform to sound engineering practice. The entire installation shall be such as to cause minimum transmission of noise and vibration to the building structure. All equipment and materials to be used in work shall be manufactured in factories of good repute having excellent track record of quality, manufacturing, performance and proper after sales service.

## STATUTORY CLEARANCES

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The contractor shall obtain necessary clearance from the concerned statutory body including permission, approval of drawings and necessary documents etc as per the mandatory requirements prevailing in the NCR/Delhi for Electrical Installation as required. Necessary fee, if any, shall be paid by the contractor and reimbursement shall be made by AOA, KV-II as extra on production of original fee receipt.

# COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS AND INDIAN STANDARDS

#### INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE

#### **GUARANTEE**

All equipment shall be guaranteed for a period of 36 month, from the date of taking over the installation by AOA, KV-II, against unsatisfactory performance and/or break down due to defective design, workmanship or material. The equipment or components, or any part thereof, so found defective during guarantee period shall be forthwith repaired or replaced free of cost, to the satisfaction of BOM, AOA, KV-II. In case it is felt by the AOA, KV-II that undue delay is being caused by the contractor in doing this, the same will be got done by the AOA, KV-II at the risk and cost of the contractor. The decision of the In-charge Electricals and Lifts, AOA, KV-2 in this regard shall be final & binding on the contractor. The tender shall guarantee among other things, the following

1. Quality, strength and performance of the materials used.

2. Safe mechanical and electrical stress on all parts under all specified conditions of operation.

3. Satisfactory operation during the maintenance period.
