Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

Time and again It is noticed that the stray dogs loitering inside KV-II campus are still found attacking on not only minors but also ladies and old aged persons leading to them to take medical assistance by virtue of perceived bite leading to a sense of insecurity in residents their movement for walk around the KV-II campus. It is seen very often that in spite of advisory /SOP issued by BOM on 15.05.2022, some of the dog enthusiasts still use to feed them on regular basis which help the stray dogs to live in comfort zone in the campus. Therefore, in order to stall such recurrence, there is an immediate need to prevent residents and their family from nuisance of such dogs living already in the campus.

- 2. Accordingly it is urged once gain by the BOM that all the residents should adhere to the following measures as stated hereunder:
 - All the Dog enthusiasts are advised not to feed the dogs in the common area of KV-II campus.
 - 2) Further, Dog enthusiasts are advised to not to provide any shelter to dogs and pups.
 - 3) Dog enthusiasts are also advised to feed the dogs only outside of KV-II campus.
 - 4) The dog owners are also advised to take their dogs outside of KV-II campus for their natural call and not on the roads and parks in and around the campus of KV-II.
 - 5) In case of any emergencies, dog owners are advised to take their responsibility to pick the shit of their dogs/pets and dispose of the same at appropriate place ie dust bins placed inside the campus.
 - 6) The residents are asked not to hit any dog in the campus in order to maintain PETA guidelines.
 - 7) The residents are also advised not to irritate the dogs in any manner to make them furious.
 - 8) The residents are advised not to leave their kids/minors/wards/ old aged person alone in the parks.
 - 9) The residents are advised not to use Lift with their pets/ dogs.
