NOTICE FOR INVITING TENDER FOR ROAD REPAIR AND RE-CARPETING

Sealed tender are hereby invited on the behalf of BOM, Apartment Owners Associations, Kendriya Vihar, Sector-82, Noida for Repair of Road Carpeting inside the Kendriya Vihar-II complex as per schedule attached as Annexure-I from genuine contractors. The contractor can purchase the tender document from AOA, KV-II office or can be download from the website till 19.06.2022 up to 02:00 PM. The tender shall be opened on 19.06.2022 at 04:00 PM in the presence of contractor/members who intended to be present as per terms and conditions given below:

Terms and Conditions:

1. The contractor duly registered with any Government Authority for similar work carried out in the past as detailed below:
 - i) One work costing for more than Rs. 51.00 Lakh; or
 - ii) Two works costing more than Rs. 38 Lakh each; or
 - iii) Three works costing more than Rs.26 Lakh each.
2. The contractor has to quote the item wise rate including all taxes as per schedule of quantities attached at Annexure-I both in figure and words.
3. The payment shall be made after satisfactory completion of the work as per actual measurement in the form of running payment and final payment. TDS as applicable shall be deducted from bill
4. The work has to be carried out as per specification and as per satisfaction of BOM, AOA. The decision of BOM, AOA shall be final in this regard.
5. The contractor has to deposit DD of Rs. 65,000/- as Earnest Money with the tender in the form of bank draft in favour of KV II AOA payable at Noida. The EMD of the unsuccessful contractors shall be returned after award of work to successful bidder while EMD of the successful bidder shall be adjusted against Security Deposit in lieu of performance.
6. The successful contractor has to deposit the 5% of bid amount as performance guarantee at the start of work. The same shall be returned after completion of work.
7. The security deposit of 5% of bid amount shall be deducted from the bill (s) of the contractor and same shall be refunded after 6 month of completion of work.
8. The cost of tender shall be Rs. 1000/- (+GST) which shall be non-refundable. The contractors who are downloading the tender from KV-II website will have to deposit the draft of Rs. 1000/-+(GST) / Cash along with the tender document.

9. The BOM, AOA reserves the right to reject the tender without assigning any reason at any point of time.
10. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 01 Month after award of work. If contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated period a penalty of 1.0 % of the contract amount per week will be imposed upon the firm as decided by BOM.
11. Scanned copy of an affidavit with definite proof regarding ownership of owning hot mix plant installed in NCR (Batch Mix type only) fitted with electronic controls & screens of capacity 100-120 tonne (30-40 Cum) per hour and two Hydrostatic paver finishers fitted with electronic sensor control having capable of paving 6.0 metre width and upto 250mm lift and Vibratory Road Rollers conforming to MORTH specifications all in good working condition as on date of uploading of tender.
12. Scanned copy of valid No Objection Certificate from Pollution Control Board of respective region for running of Hot Mix Plant.
13. The Contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/Registration or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, Registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No.
14. It is also made clear that intending tenderer should visit the sites of work and physically assess the activities which are involved for completing the work, including the quantum of work besides the information supplied in the tender document. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained on this account.

Providing and applying tack coat using hot straight run bitumen of grade VG 10 including heating the bitumen, spraying the bitumen with mechanically operated spray unit fitted on bitumen boiler, cleaning and preparing the existing road surfaces as per specifications on bituminous surfaces @ 0.50 Kg / Sqm	15000	Sqm.			
2.	Providing and laying bituminous concrete with higher capacity batch type HMP using crushed aggregates of specified grading premixed with bituminous binder @5.4 per cent by weight of total mix and filler transporting the hot mix to work site laying with a hydrostatic pavar finisher with sensor control to the required grade level and alignment rolling with smooth wheeled vibratory and tandem rollers to achieve the desired compaction as per MORTH specification clause no.507 complete in all respects. Providing and laying Dense Graded Bituminous Macadam using crushed stone aggregates of specified grading, premixed with bituminous binder and filler, transporting the hot mix to work site by tippers, laying with paver finisher equipped with electronic sensor to the required grade, level and alignment and rolling with smooth wheeled, vibratory and tandem rollers as per specifications to achieve the desired compaction and density, complete as per specifications and directions of Engineer-in-Charge. 50 to 100 mm average compacted thickness with bitumen of grade VG-30 @ 5% (percentage by weight of total mix) and lime filler @ 2% (percentage by weight of Aggregate) prepared in Batch Type Hot Mix Plant of 100-120 TPH capacity.	100	Cum.

Condition of Contract

1. The contractor (s) shall make his own arrangement for electricity and water required for the execution of work and nothing extra shall be paid for the same.
2. Clearing of sites to be satisfaction of the BOM, AOA after completion of entire work and handing over the same to the department of BOM, AOA.
3. The contractor shall make provision for all safety measures for traffic, pedestrian workmen, machinery etc. as considered necessary by the BOM, AOA.
4. Royalty at the prevalent rates and all other incidental expenditure shall have to be paid by the contractor on all the, metal shingle, earth sand, bajri etc. collected by him for the execution of the work direct to the concerned Revenue Authority of the State or Central Govt. His rates are deemed to be included all such expenditure and nothing extra shall be paid.
5. The malba / garbage, removed from the site shall be disposed off by the contractor at any suitable place as directed by the BOM, AOA. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
6. The contractor shall submit the declaration to this effect that the mandatory subscriptions towards Provident Fund, ESIC etc in respect of their workers are being paid regularly.
7. The contractor shall ensure the disbursement of wages to the workers as per prevailing labour laws. It is the responsibility of contractor to fulfil all statutory laws in this regard.
8. The dismantle material/building rubbish received from dismantling/demolishing shall be dumped to the dumping ground in properly covered truck with precaution. Any penalty imposed by authorities due to violation of same shall be born by the contractor.
9. Agency/contractor shall not dump the construction material on the metalled road and shall keep the construction material on the physically demarcated space by the BOM, AOA.
10. All the material responsible for pollution shall be brought at site from sources covered by tarpaulin and shall take all precautionary measure to ensure that no dust particles are permitted to pollute the air quality., Any penalty imposed by authorities due to violation of same shall be born by the contractor.
11. All the trucks or vehicles of any kind, which are used for construction/repair/carpeting purpose and/or are carrying construction materials like cement, sand, bitumen, grits and other allied material, shall be fully covered in the process of transporting the material.
12. The construction material of any kind that is stored in the site will be fully covered in all respects so that it does not disperse in the Air in any form.
13. Every worker working on the construction site and involved in loading, unloading and carriage of construction material and construction debris shall be provided with mask to prevent inhalation of dust particles.
14. Contractor should provide all medical help, investigation and treatment to the workers involved in the construction of building and carry of construction material and debris relatable to dust emission.
15. There shall be no burning of leaves, plastic etc at construction site.
16. Contractor should ensure the compliance of directives of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal orders dated 04-12-2014 and 10.04.2015 in O.A. No. 21 of 2014 and O.A. No. 95 of 2014 and MoEF guidelines of 2010 regarding dealing with Air Pollution from construction and demolition sites.

adjust the program for execution of work accordingly. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.

33. Penalty:

In case, the Contractor fails to provide the services as per Terms & Conditions of a signed contract and execute the work as per specification, the performance guarantee shall be forfeited which shall be decided by the AOA/BOM.

34 (i) Arbitration:

In case conciliation proceedings do not fructify, arbitration shall be resorted. Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating to the construction, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this contract or the validity of the breach thereof shall be settled by arbitration. In this case the **President, AOA, BOM, KV-II** will be the sole arbitrator. The provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act -1996 shall apply to such arbitration proceedings and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties. The venue of arbitration shall be KV-II, NOIDA. The language of the arbitration shall be English.

(ii) Exclusive Jurisdiction:

The parties hereto agree that any matter or issues arising hereunder or any dispute hereunder shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Gautam Budh Nagar (Uttar Pradesh) only.
